

# Adobe Acrobat Install (for greybar update)

This tutorial will show you how to download Adobe Acrobat DC to use for updates to the section offering


(greybar) e-Report PDF process. Download Adobe Acrobat DC, which is needed to make comments on PDF's.

There are four ways of getting Adobe Acrobat DC:


1. Download Adobe Acrobat from Software Center
2. Download Adobe Creative Cloud from Software Center, login, and download the Adobe Acrobat DC App.
3. Download Adobe Creative Cloud from Adobe.com, login, and download the Adobe Acrobat DC app.
4. If your department is not supported by university IT, contact your department systems team to obtain the Adobe Acrobat DC download.

## Option 1: Download Adobe Acrobat from Software Center


1. Open Software Center



2. Locate Adobe Acrobat DC and select the Icon






## Option 2: Download Adobe Creative Cloud from Software Center, login, and download the Adobe Acrobat DC App




Step 2: Locate Adobe Creative Cloud Desktop App and select the Icon




Step 3: Install Adobe Creative Cloud Desktop App




Step 4: Open Adobe Creative Cloud Desktop App




Step 5: Log into Adobe Creative Cloud using your NetID and Password



## Step 6: Authenticate your login with OKTA




## Step 7: Once in Creative Cloud, select "All Apps" and then find Acrobat DC and install




## Option 3: Download Adobe Creative Cloud from [Adobe.com](https://www.adobe.com), login, and download the Adobe Acrobat DC app.


Step 5: Open Adobe Creative Cloud Desktop App
